Your vehicle is parked in a space, which is designated for use by electric vehicles for the purpose of charging.

Electric vehicles are the same as internal combustion engine vehicles, except for the type of fuel they use. When you need to refuel, you stop at a gasoline/diesel station. You can imagine how you would feel if you arrived at a refueling station, low on fuel, and found you could not fill up because other vehicles, not refueling, were blocking all of the pumps.

California Vehicle Code Sections 22511 and 22511.1 prohibit vehicles from parking in marked parking spaces that are designated for the purpose of electric vehicle charging, unless they are charging.

Hopefully, you will find this information helpful in understanding that drivers of electric vehicles want to be able to get home as much as you do.
